

URGENT TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A350 BOURNEMOUTH ROAD, BLANDFORD ST MARY

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles, cyclists and horse riders will be prohibited from proceeding along A350 Bournemouth Road, Blandford St Mary between its junction with Badger Roundabout, Blandford St Mary and its junction with Park Hill, Charlton Marshall, a distance of approximately 1630 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation at 19:00 on 4th August 2023 with the closure in place 24hrs a day and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 24th August 2023. Residents access will be maintained throughout.

This Order will enable SGN to carry out an urgent gas mains replacement in the highway.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: A354 - A35 - A31
